It is suggested that this Office be granted authority to write an anonymous letter to the National Office of CORE in New York and advise them of the plans of and to form a chapter in San Francisco and relate they are both CP members. The letter will be written indicating that the writer was approached by for membership in the CP and will indicate disgust with attempts to infiltrate such an organization. All necessary precautions will be taken not to disclose any connections with the FBI.

As a member of NAACP, I know the trouble the communist can cause in a group and I am sure CORE wants no more to do with the CP than we do in the NAACP.

"I know that this woman was one of the persons brought before the HCUA in San Francisco last year for communist activity and she still talks like a communist.

"For what its worth this will alert you to the fact that she and others of her kind have plans to have a CORE chapter in San Francisco and use your group for their own purposes.

Any tangible results noted will be immediately forwarded to the Bureau.
